Aviary volunteers are responsible for caring for the birds including cleaning the bird display cases. There are two aviaries in Lake Winona Manor, one on each floor.

Minimum Requirements

It is also important for volunteers to read, understand and exemplify Winona Health's Mission, Vision, Values and Behavioral Standards.

- Exceptional attention to detail
- Willingness to get a little dirty, if necessary
- Comfortable working in small spaces with birds
